Internship Program Overview- Intern

Program Overview: On Point for College is sponsoring a paid internship program to help our students and graduates gain meaningful pre-professional work experience. Interns will be matched with employers related to their field of study in the Syracuse and Utica areas through our On Point for College Career Services program.

What is an internship?

- An internship is a form of experiential learning that integrates knowledge learned in the classroom with practical application and skills development in a professional setting.
- Internships give students an opportunity to gain valuable applied experience and make connections in professional fields.

What is the On Point for College Internship?

- Paid internship where participants are paid \$10.50 per hour
- During the internship program participants will need to complete enrichment workshops depending on the length of their internship

Who is eligible for the Internship Program?

- College students and training/college graduates who are enrolled in On Point for College
- Applicants must meet income eligibility requirements

When is the internship?

- Internships will occur over this Spring Semester 2018 (January 2018 April 27, 2018)
- Internships can be between 6 8 weeks
- Interns will be working between 10 20 hours per week

Where will I be working?

• On Point for College will pair interns with local employers that we have relationships with and whose work aligns with your career interests. If there is a particular employer that you have a relationship with and where you would like to work, it may be possible to place you there.

Why should I apply for an internship?

- Get paid to learn about a job or industry
- Gain on-the-job training and experience that can enhance your resume
- "Try on" a job or company before you commit to a fulltime job or career
- Have flexible scheduling that can work around your classes and other obligations
